Graduate Application (for foreign applicants)

- Student accomplishes application form and submits required documents to the Student Records Section on or before the deadline set by the college or school
- 2. Submit the following requirements:
 - · Application Form
 - · Official Receipt of Application Fee
 - · Official Transcript of Records
 - · Photocopy of Birth Certificate, original to be presented
 - Photocopy of Marriage Certificate, original to be presented (if married woman)
 - Applicants whose medium of instruction in their previous school is NOT English should take and pass TOEFL with minimum score of 500 if paper-based, 173 if computer-based, or 61 if internet-based test or IELTS with minimum scores of 5.5
 - · Other documents required by the college
- 3. Student follow-up the result of evaluation on the date identified by the college or school
- 4. College SRE informs the accepted applicant of the results and issues the following:
 - a. Notice of Acceptance;
 - b. List of requirements to be submitted to ARS-OUR; and
 - c. Referral slip to UPHS for Medical Certificate
- College SRE gives the Form 002 (College Admission Slip) to accepted applicant and two copies of Student Directory (to be accomplished by the student) to be forwarded to the ARS-OUR
- 6. ARS-OUR will issue an Acceptance Letter needed to get a student visa for the issuance of Study Permit from OSA
- 7. Student submits the following to the ARS-OUR for issuance of University Admission Slip:
 - a. College Admission Slip (Form 002)
 - b. Two copies of accomplished Student Directory with photos
 - c. Medical Certificate from the UPHS
 - d. Photocopy of Birth Certificate, original to be presented
 - e. Photocopy of Marriage Certificate, original to be presented (if married woman)
 - f. Transcript used for evaluation duly stamped and signed by the Student Records Evaluator or College Secretary at the back of the TOR.
 - g. Official Transcript of Records to be submitted in a sealed envelope/Authenticated copy of TOR
 - h. Study permit from OSA
 - i. Photocopy of passport, original to be presented
 - j. Plan of Study
